Rooms, beds, food, clothing, case management, vocational services, children's programs, and more are available to up to 24 families at once for 120 days each, helping families of all sizes secure permanent housing and become self-sustaining.

Over 87 percent of residents who entered The Salvation Army Phoenix Emergency Family Shelter Program in 2023 moved into stable housing.
