Provides a mobile hydration unit, indoor cooling center, sun-protective supplies, and more to save lives during excessive heat.

Provides street outreach to families experiencing homelessness, bringing them food, clothing, diapers, hygiene products, and transportation assistance as they wait for shelter space.
